SERVING @ THE COMMUNITY CHURCH -

As a church, we uphold the value that serving is an integral part of who we are as people of worship. Therefore, we use our gifts and abilities to help others.

As Christ builds his church it is shaped and built through the gifts He places within the body (1 Corinthians 12:12-27). As such, this booklet is evolving and is not an exhaustive list of the serving opportunities within our Church or wider community.

We hope and pray that as you go through this booklet, you will be able to discover the different ministries our church offers and how we serve the wider community. We believe that you will find where your talents and skills fit best and that you will be able to grow and bear fruits as you serve.

The biblical model was for ministry and service to be done in teams. Jesus modelled this with His team of disciples around Him and Paul continued that practice. Therefore, all our serving opportunities are in the context of a team with a team leader. All the team leaders are supported and overseen by Aderyn (Development Director) on behalf of the SLT.

In serving, you will be part of a wider team, and it is a great way of getting to know new people, have fellowship, grow in your own discipleship and encourage others in theirs.

You will be able to see a brief description of each ministry and serving opportunity, and we welcome you to connect with the team's ministry leader or Aderyn to explore more.

Additionally, as you explore joining a serving team, please know you will receive encouragement and support and training will be provided where needed.

Serving roles are available across both locations in the Forest and Wye and you can opt for both locations or where you attend the most.

Our serving opportunities are broken into two areas of focus: IN - serving to build the body of the church (To know Christ) OUT - serving to reach out to the community (To make Him Known)

KIDS AND YOUTH MINISTRTY



<u>Sundays</u>

Our Children and youth meet in age related-groups during part of the Sunday service for Bible Study, Games and Discipleship.

Currently, we have: Pre-school 2-4 years old Primary School Years 1-6 Youth Secondary Years 7-11

The Bridge - Friday Nights

As part of our outreach to young people, we run an end-of-week youth club, with varied games and activities each week and a "focus" time where we explore a topic from a Christian perspective.

As part of these teams you can:

- Plan and lead the session/teaching
- Assist with leading the session
- Contribute to the session

Events and camps

Throughout the year we may have one off events (Easter, Christmas etc) and summer clubs and camps. These have a dual approach of providing both an opportunity for those with Children & Youth within the Church whilst extending opportunities to the wider community.

These events are a great way of continuing your ministry to Kids & Youth beyond Sundays and midweek or as a one off through a team leader of helper role.

- Able to work within the Team and accept training and guidance;
- Able to maintain confidentiality in an appropriate manner.

These are supposed to be fun and informal ways to trial and test where you're best shaped to serve from your heart. We will work with you to empower and equip you to serve best in a place that develops you and the church!

<u>Training</u>

Some ministries will require training, which the church will provide or cover the costs for an external trainer, once you are a full member of the team.

All ministry leaders and some team members are expected to complete Safeguarding Training Level 2 or provide evidence that they have a current certificate.
