## COVID 19: Update

***Measures to ensure the health of us all and the continued witness of Forest Community Church in the local community***

**(Update to the COVID Policy dated 10/12/2021)**

With the Omicrom strain of the virus presenting a continued serious health risk, we have the following measures to help minimise the risk for those visiting our church building.

### **In FWCC:**

- **People are free to choose whether they wear masks or not.**
- **We provide hand sanitizer for people to use.**
- **We try to keep the building well ventilated.**
- **We have regular Covid safe cleaning.**
- **In line with government regulations, mask wearing is not required when eating, drinking or singing.**

**We request that everyone is respectful of those with differing views.**

**We ask people who are unwell and suspect they could have covid, to not enter the church premises.**

**We expect people to follow the government guidance about self-isolation and not enter our premises if they are expected to self-isolate.**
