# Experience His Provision Life in the in-between land pt 6 Joshua 1-5:1

To experience His provision...

## 1. Listen to His Word

"After the death of Moses the Lord's servant, the Lord spoke to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' assistant. He said, <sup>2</sup> "Moses my servant is dead. Therefore, the time has come for you to lead these people, the Israelites, across the Jordan River into the land I am giving them." Joshua 1:1-2

- O What is God saying through his <u>Word</u>?
- O What are trusted godly people advising me?
- O Do my <u>circumstances</u> indicate this makes sense?
- Is God confirming to me through prophetic word? Test this!

# 2. Prepare yourself by being <u>pure</u> and <u>humble</u>

Then Joshua told the people, "Purify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do great wonders among you." Joshua 3:5

"In a wealthy home some utensils are made of gold and silver, and some are made of wood and clay. The expensive utensils are used for special occasions, and the cheap ones are for everyday use. <sup>21</sup> If you keep yourself pure, you will be a special utensil for honourable use. Your life will be clean, and you will be ready for the Master to use you for every good work.

<sup>22</sup> Run from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts." 2 Tim 2:20-22

"The Lord told Joshua, 'Today I will begin to make you a great leader in the eyes of all the Israelites. They will know that I am with you, just as I was with Moses." Joshua 3:6

"So humble yourselves before God...Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world. <sup>9</sup> Let there be tears for what you have done. Let there be sorrow and deep grief. Let there be sadness instead of laughter, and gloom instead of joy. <sup>10</sup> Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honour." James 4:7-10

### 3. Obey His instruction

"In the morning Joshua said to the priests, "Lift up the Ark of the Covenant and lead the people across the river." And so they started out and went ahead of the people." Joshua 3:6

# 4. Move forward in expectation

"It was the harvest season, and the Jordan was overflowing its banks. But as soon as the feet of the priests who were carrying the Ark touched the water at the river's edge, <sup>16</sup> the water above that point began backing up a great distance away at a town called Adam, which is near Zarethan. And the water below that point flowed on to the Dead Sea until the riverbed was dry. Then all the people crossed over near the town of Jericho." Joshua 3:15-16

"Meanwhile, the priests who were carrying the Ark of the Lord's Covenant stood on dry ground in the middle of the riverbed as the people passed by. They waited there until the whole nation of Israel had crossed the Jordan on dry ground." Joshua 3:17

### 5. Remember God did it!

"We will use these stones to build a memorial. In the future your children will ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' <sup>7</sup>Then you can tell them, 'They remind us that the Jordan River stopped flowing when the Ark of the Lord's Covenant went across.' These stones will stand as a memorial among the people of Israel forever." Joshua 4:6
